**Senior Recognition**

The school district will recognize the outstanding academic achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner **(for the graduating classes of 2016, 2017, and 2018 only):**

Valedictorian – The graduating Senior with the highest cumulative grade point average.

Salutatorian – The graduating Senior with the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest cumulative grade point average.

Honor Graduate – Any Senior graduating with a cumulative grade point average of 95% or higher.

Students not attending Seward High School for both semesters during their senior year of high school will not be eligible for Valedictorian and/or Salutatorian recognition. They will be eligible to be recognized as an Honor Graduate.

**The following system will replace the system detailed above starting with the graduating class of 2019.**

The school district will recognize the outstanding academic achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner:

Summa Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. of 4.0 or greater

Magna Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. between 3.833 – 3.999

Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. between 3.667 – 3.832
