6007 Senior Recognition

The school district will recognize the outstanding academic achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner (for the graduating classes of 2016, 2017, and 2018 only):

Valedictorian – The graduating Senior with the highest cumulative grade point average.

Salutatorian – The graduating Senior with the 2nd highest cumulative grade point average.

Honor Graduate – Any Senior graduating with a cumulative grade point average of 95% or higher.

Students not attending Seward High School for both semesters during their senior year of high school will not be eligible for Valedictorian and/or Salutatorian recognition. They will be eligible to be recognized as an Honor Graduate.

The following system will replace the system detailed above starting with the graduating class of 2019.

The school district will recognize the outstanding academic achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner:

Summa Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. of 4.0 or greater

Magna Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. between 3.833 – 3.999

Cum Laude – A graduating senior with a cumulative G.P.A. between 3.667 – 3.832
